Conversation starters to use in workshops, and examples of variables they may connect to based on background research, and example questions to ignite the discussions.

Conversation starters	Examples of possible connections	Example of questions
Infrastructure	Roads, power grids, wastewater treatment, internet, ports, underwater cables, educational institutions, and waterways.	Are there any differences in road quality in Senja? Does that pose as a challenge for development?
Water quality	Fresh and saline water, eutrophication, and availability of clean water.	Water quality is important for many industries and have generated big headlines in the local newspapers with frictions between industries, what do you think about this?
Pollution	Sludge from aquaculture, lost fishing gear, runoff from agriculture, littering by locals and tourists, sea lice, salmon escapees, and biodiversity.	Do you experience any challenges with pollution from other stakeholders?
Regulations/policies	The SDGs, administrative complexity, fishing quotas, human migration, traceability, biodegradable materials, and conservation.	Are there any national or local regulations that are makes development particularly challenging? Why?
Climate change	Temperature, invasive species, precipitation, and species migration.	Do you think increasing temperatures will be beneficial or detrimental for industrial activity in northern Norway?
Human consumption patterns/customer preferences	Sustainability reporting on food production, new utilization of raw materials, locally produced food, aquaculture of cod, salmon, or kelp, and rest raw materials.	What is it that affects customers consumption patterns?
